CHARTER OF THE OVPR CONFLICT OF INTEREST REVIEW COMMITTEE
(from the Policy and Procedures for Dealing with Financial and Outside
Management Conflicts of Interest in Sponsored Projects and Technology Transfer)

The Committee will consist of at least five individuals named by the Vice President for Research.

The review committee may:

- Allow the proposal to go forward without modification, or
- Require some specific type of administrative oversight or management, or
- Recommend the withdrawal of the proposal or suspension of the technology transfer arrangement.

The Committee will also make an initial determination whether any situation that has been allowed to go forward triggers the State Conflict of Interest law.

The review Committee will have the assistance of an administrative official in handling the flow of paperwork, correspondence, record keeping, and the oversight and implementation of management decisions made by the committee. Support to the OVPR Conflict of Interest Review Committee will be provided by the Office of the Vice President for Research.
